- Board Meeting (Feb 6, '08): Lion President Gallaway called the Le Grand Lions Executive Board meeting to order. Members present were Lions Doug Gallaway, Sonny Hultgren, Louie Aguilar, Rob Glasgow, George Dickinson, Concie Moreno, Ron Raines, Jim Pacheco, Bob Enochs, Gail Wills, Jeff Stephens, Scott Lucas, and Fred Silveira.
- Minutes of January meeting were read and declared approved. The treasurer's report was then given, Lion Jeff indicated a new computer program is now being used so the printed form looks somewhat different than before. Lion Doug inquired if there are enough funds on hand to buy cattle for a fund raiser as was done before. Lion Jeff indicated there is. Motion by Lion Bob, seconded by Lion Jeff to spend funds for the project. Lion Doug will look into costs before actual commencement of the fund raiser.
- Lions Club Convention will be held at South Lake Tahoe, April 17-20th. Zone Chair, Ron Snipes, advised that the next level for Student Speaker Night will be held at DiCicco's in Madera, March 5th.
- The Le Grand Lions Spring Dinner/Dance was discussed. It will be held on May 24th the same date as Community Day. Dinner/Dance tickets: \$35.00; Dance tickets: \$10.00. Cost for the band from 8 to 11pm will be \$500. Portable restrooms will be provided. Those purchasing liquor drinks must be 21 years or older and will be identified by wristbands. Security personnel will be provided, probably at least two. The event will be held at Eddie Bright's place.
- Lion Doug did follow-up on the Light Up Le Grand funding with Dario/Josephine Giampaoli. Le Grand Lions will send them \$850 to reimburse expenses
- Le Grand 4H has made a request of Le Grand Lions to purchase three sewing machines. Moved by Lion Scott/seconded by Lion Bob to allocate funds. Motion passed.
- Discussions: Lion Ron proposes that a light system be installed from the VFW barbecue area to the trailer in the back. Lion Doug indicated he has lights and will bring them at the next dinner meeting. Lion Bob has been contacted to oversee a Le Grand High School Winter Sports dinner on the 25th of February. He will be forming a cooking crew for the event.. Should the Le Grand Lions barbecue (the one on wheels) be repaired, updated, or even replaced? General consensus was to buy a new one. Lion Sonny will provide follow-up and details at next meeting.
- February cooking duties will be headed by Lion Sonny. Dinner meeting, February 20th
