- **Board Meeting (May 2, 2012):** Meeting called to order by President Bob Enochs at the ALH. Members present were Lions Bob Enochs, Doug Gallaway, Jim Tesone, Richard Kilgore, Ken McPherson, Bill Frizell, Fred Reeves, Ron Raines, Sonny Hultgren, Joe Fausone, Anne Vandermeer, and Fred Silveira.
- Lion FredS apprised the board of correspondence received since last month's meeting. Rick Furey has resigned from the club. The April bulletin/minutes was declared accepted as printed. Lion JimT gave a treasurer's report and indicated the club now has extended insurance coverage/conditions specific to the serving of liquor at the same policy cost as before. All members are paid and to date with dues for the January-June 2012 period, except for two.
- To comply with rules of order as to new agenda items, a vote was taken again and was approved to raise dues by \$25 per each sixth month period starting with the July-December 2012 membership frame. Dues will be \$95 per each membership cycle. The increase will produce needed general funds which were tentatively generated in the past by fund raisers as the barn/dinner dance. - LGLC was originally scheduled to cook and serve at the Le Grand High School Senior Breakfast, but has been revised with the club needing only to serve (in addition to subsidizing funding for the event (as passed in motion2/March 2012). The club will also, as in the past, be serving at the Chowchilla Spring Fair, May 19th. Lion Ken-McP is in charge and is in need of help from club members. LGLC will be cooking on May 24th for the FFA banquet.
- Lion Doug confirmed two \$500 scholarships will be granted this year. Of consideration for next year is a proposal to open eligibility for applications in academic areas other than agriculture, with fields of agriculture study having priority.
- Motion passed to allocate \$500 [\$250 liquor license value; \$250 cash) towards a "Texas-Hold'em" style fund raiser for the Plainsburg/Helm Cemetary District. LGLC will also provide logistic help with needed set-up and materials. The event is scheduled on June 9th. [m/2-May 2012; moved: Lion Rick; second: Lion Ron]
