- Board Meeting (May 7, '08): Lion President Gallaway called the Le Grand Lions Executive Board meeting to order. - Minutes of the April meeting were read and declared approved. The treasurer's report was then given and approved. - Motion made and passed for a \$500 grant to Veronica Moreno to help defray travel expenses for "The Force" community softball team.
- Discussions & Commentaries: Le Grand Lions pins have been ordered. Lion Greg Soto is gathering materials for repair of the American Legion Hall barbeque. Repair of the club's portable barbeque is still on track. Scholarship applicant reviews will be held on May 13th in the park by Lion Doug in assistance with other Le Grand Lions members. Installation of club officers for the 2008-09 year will be conducted, June 18th, during a dinner meeting at Reiner's restaurant in Merced. The Chowchilla Fair is May 17th and purchase of animals by the club will continue in the method as in the past. There may be a request for Lions members to help serve at the fair. The pancake breakfast is scheduled for June 14th. Lion Doug (board did approve) has ordered 12 blue polo shirts which are embossed with the Le Grand Lions logo.
