- Board Meeting (Feb 4, '09): Lion President Doug Gallaway called the Le Grand Lions Executive Board meeting to order. - Minutes of the January meeting were read by Lion Scott. Lion Jeff presented the treasurer's report. For those on a 6 month payment plan (rather than yearly), members are reminded to pay their dues.
- Discussion was again opened as to whether or not LGLC should have a spring dinner/dance. After various considerations, the board voted to schedule the event on Le Grand Community Day. The feeling was last year's dinner/dance was successful and the potential for even a better result is possible this year. Details will be formulated later.
- There are 8 Camp Pacifica director positions available. Lion Louie was asked if he wished to be placed into nomination, but declined.
- District Governor Pat Casey-Gillum congratulated Le Grand Lions Club on its 69th anniversary.
- Board passed a motion to provide bar and help cook for the George Hines Retirement Party which will be held at the American Legion Hall, May 2nd. Lion Rob will secure the liquor license.
- Lion Ron Raines asked \$45 be approved for purchase of a computer program to enhance the website. Motion approved. He also requested LGLC provide a lunch (as was done in November) for participants attending the second computer technology seminar scheduled at Le Grand Elementary School on March 14th. The board opted for attendees being on their own for lunch.
- Motion passed for LGLC providing bar and permit for the Tri-City Youth Football Dinner on April 25th.
- This month's general meeting marks the official visit of the district governor. Some members of the Atwater-Winton Lions Club will also be attending. Lion Doug encouraged Le Grand members to show a good turnout.
