- Board Meeting (March 4, '09): Lion President Doug Gallaway called the Le Grand Lions Executive Board meeting to order. - Minutes of the January meeting were read by Lion Scott. The treasurer's report was presented to the board by Lion Doug on behalf of Lion Jeff who was not able to make the meeting. Members who are on a 6 month payment schedule are once again reminded to pay their dues. Some payments were brought to date since last month's meeting.
- The Spring Dinner/Dance is set for May 23<sup>rd</sup>, which coincides with Le Grand Community Day. As with last year, the event will be held at Eddie Bright's barn. Lion Ron will serve as chairman. Various logistics were discussed and some members have already volunteered for various sub-chair responsibilities. All LGLC members will be requested to help setup and in turn assist with cleanup. Tickets for the dinner/dance will be \$30 per person and \$10 for dance only. Dinner/dance tickets will be exclusively presale while dance tickets will be sold only at the door. The no host drink session is scheduled from 6 to 7pm with dinner at 7 and then the dance afterwards. More details will be determined as the event draws nearer.
- The board allocated expenditure of \$25 as a donation in Governor Pat Casey-Gillum's name for a Helen Keller Fellowship Award.
- Applications are available through Lion Doug for "camperships" to Camp Pacifica. LGLC gives preference to local applicants, but is open to sponsoring participants outside the region in helping offset their costs in attending the camp.
- LGLC will supply bar and help cook for the George Hines Retirement Party which is scheduled at the American Legion Hall on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Lion Rob will obtain the liquor license.
- A second computer technology seminar will be conducted by Lion Ron on March 14th at Le Grand Elementary School. The purpose is to help Lion clubs within the region to design and maintain their own webpages.
- LGLC will provide bar and permit for the Tri-City Youth Football Dinner on April 25th.
- This month's general meeting is Ladies' Night and a corn beef and cabbage dinner will be served. Lion Bob will contact members to determine an attendance count.
