- Lion Fred/S covered minutes of last month's meeting, mainly focusing on motions made and passed, with the
 remainder business having been reported in the club bulletin. Lion Jeff presented the treasurer's report. Additional
 funds have been received from the pancake breakfast with some proceeds pending. Required tax reports have been
 filed with the IRS. Dues are up to date for the 2010 July-December period except for ten members.
- Lion Ron distributed the club's 2010 Top Club Award point standing, currently towards the top of competition. It is incumbent for members to report their monthly volunteer activity to either Lions Ron or Fred/S for point accumulation.
- Bank forms have been completed establishing Lions Jeff Stephens, Doug Gallaway, Scott Lucas, Concie Moreno and Fred Silveira as signatories for the club's checking account.

 Nick Marchini for prospective membership. Name badges have been ordered for Lions Pete, Joe, and Fred/Q.
- The club thanks the following members for their service (lunch, dinner) at Camp Pacifica this week: Lions Louie and his
 granddaughter, Shannon; Gail and Jeanne; Ken/M; Ken/S; and Fred/S. In addition, Lion Ron transported participants
 on Sunday [two trips] from the Mt. Bullion Airport to the camp. Lion Louie as chairman gets accolades for his superb
 planning, organization and management of the activities. Conditions couldn't have gone more smoothly.
- For providing monthly executive board meeting facilities at El Vecino, a motion was approved to waive Lion Concie's
