- Board Meeting (July 6, 2011): Meeting called to order by outgoing Lion President Ron Raines at El Vecino. Members
  present were Lions Ron Raines, Bob Enochs, Sonny Hultgren, Doug Gallaway, Richard Kilgore, Jim Pacheco, Concie
  Moreno, Bill Frizell, Jeff Stephens, Don Wilson, Anne Vandermeer, Jim Tesone, Ken McPherson, and Fred Silveira.
- Lion Fred reported on minutes and the one motion from the June meeting. After serving as LGLC Treasurer for the last
  eight years, Lion Jeff presented his final monthly treasurer's report. Money from the dinner/barn dance and expenses
  are still pending although it is now apparent the club is not going to generate as much revenue from the event as that
  of last year. That being so, general commentary by members of the executive board is to entertain holding a different
  kind of general fund raiser in lieu of the dinner barn/dance.
- Lion Bob advised that plans for the Pancake Breakfast in the Park are in place with extensive background logistic help from Lion Jim-P. The breakfast benefits the local cancer society and is being held, Saturday, July 9th, from 7am to 11am. Sausage, pancakes, eggs, coffee and juice will be served. Set-up is scheduled at 5:30 am.
- Motion passed to consider extending eligibility for LGLC scholarships. [m1/July2011-moved by Lion Bob, seconded by Lion Jim-T]
- Lion Doug reported on club expenditures for animals purchased at both the Chowchilla and Merced fairs. For Chowchilla, the purchase amount was \$1331 and bumps \$4532; Merced was \$919 and bumps \$3584.
- This month's general meeting will be the yearly installation dinner held at DeAngelo's (former Eagle's Nest) in Merced, on July 20th. Festivities start with no host cocktails at 6pm and dinner served at 7pm. Members will be called to ascertain attendance and reservations for how many guests.
- LGLC will be providing lunch and dinner at Camp Pacifica, July 27th. Lion Anne is chairman and requests club
  members contact him who are willing to help as part of the kitchen crew for that day.
- The executive board in appreciation applauded Lion Ron for two years of service as LGLC President and to Lion Jeff for his tenure of eight years as club treasurer.
