- Lion Fred-S reviewed minutes from the September meeting on the two motions that were passed. Lion Jim-T gave the monthly treasurer's report. Six members currently owe dues for the July through December 2011 period. Some funds will temporarily be drawn from the Compass Bank account to cover money needed on hand at the November auction.
- Motion passed (m1/October 2011) to provide a liquor license for the LGHS football social being hosted by the high school's coaches after the home coming game (LGHS vs Mariposa) at the American Legion Hall on November 4th. [moved: Lion Rick; seconded: Lion Jim-T]
- Lion Bob discussed details for the November 5th auction and is chairing it this year. Assignments: Lion Jim-P, bar; Lion Wayne, head cook; Lions Doug and Joe, auctioneers. FFA and 4-H members will help with serving the dinner and the secretaries at LGHS have volunteered to handle ticket collections at the door. Help with such logistics as set-up, collection/recording of donations at the auction, and clean-up is needed. Sign-up sheets for those needs will be distributed at the month's general meeting. Lion Bob has letters that can be used for soliciting donated items. As part of the \$10 auction ticket that includes salad, beans, rolls, and tri-tip, the club will provide beer, wine and soda. A raffle and dessert auction will be conducted in addition to the door prize drawn as part of the dinner ticket purchases.
- White Cane Day is scheduled on October 29th. Lion Bill is again head of the event and is in need of members to help until 12pm that Saturday. As with the auction, a sign-up sheet will be distributed at this month's general meeting.
